The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.173 dated 15.08.2020 under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 registered at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhjinder Singh, submits that pursuant to the order dated September 02, 2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required in the case.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated September 02, 2020 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
