Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari/mandamus for quashing the impugned list dated 07.08.2020 (P-4) and impugned transfer order dated 14.08.2020 (P-6), vide which, petitioners have been transferred.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition with liberty to make a comprehensive representation to the competent authority with the request that the same be considered in accordance with law expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Learned State Counsel has raised no objection in case the innocuous prayer of the petitioners is accepted.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, this writ petition is disposed off with liberty to the petitioners to make a representation to the competent authority within a period of two weeks from today and the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously in accordance with law preferably within two weeks thereafter in case there is no legal impediment.

It is clarified that in case the desired representation is not decided within the stipulated time, the same shall be considered as disobedience of the order of this Court.

It is also clarified that interim order dated 07.09.2020 will continue till the representation is decided in accordance with law.

Since main writ petition stands disposed off, therefore, the pending applications, if any, shall also dispose off.
