Prayer in this petition is for setting aside the order dated 10.01.2020 passed by the JMIC, Phagwara, vide which the petitioner was declared a proclaimed person in case FIR No. 125 dated 02.09.2017, registered under Sections 392, 34 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sadar Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

Considering the fact that petitioner was granted regular bail by the Court of Sessions on 15.11.2017 and later on, charges were framed on 23.07.2019 and the petitioner absented from Court proceedings on 01.01.2020, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner may be relegated to avail his remedy of filing a regular bail application before the trial Court and the trial Court may be directed to decide his regular bail application expeditiously.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today and files a regular bail application, the trial Court shall decide the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of three days thereafter.
