The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 179, dated 23.07.2020, under Sections 498-A, 406, 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Ghuman, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 14th January, 2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation. He further submits that the matter stands amicable resolved between the parties and divorce petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, has already been filed before the Family Court concerned. Further submits that the dowry articles which were in possession of the petitioner have since been returned back to respondent No.2 (complainant).

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 (complainant) does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

Learned State counsel on instructions states that the petitioner is no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 14th January, 2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
