Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for directing official respondents No.1 to 3 to take action against respondents No.4 to 6 on the basis of complaint dated 20.07.2021 (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that Gurmej Singh, husband of the petitioner, went to purchase some tablets from Sukhdev Singh @ Sukha – respondent No.4 on 20.06.2021 and due to a trifle incident, he came back home. After some time, private respondents No.4 and 5 forcibly entered to the house of petitioner, grappled with her husband and assaulted him. Counsel submits that when the petitioner tried to intervene to save her husband, the said respondents tore her cloths and outraged her modesty. On

an alarm being raised, people started gathering and the said respondents fled from the spot. Counsel submits that before approaching this Court, the petitioner has submitted a complaint to the jurisdictional police station, which was followed by a complaint dated 20.07.2021 (Annexure P-1) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur – respondent No.2, but the same have not been attended to. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the complaint.

Request made by counsel for the petitioner has been considered.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations levelled in the petition or in the complaint, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur – respondent No.2 to examine the complaint dated 20.07.2021 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law in case any substance is found in the same.

A copy of this order as well as complaint dated 20.07.2021 (Annexure P-1) be communicated to respondent No.2 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
