The petitioner, *inter alia*, seeks quashing of the order dated 30.07.2021 whereby he has been transferred and one Rajesh Kumar Khosla Executive Officer has been posted in place of the petitioner at Nagar Panchayat Nadala.

This Court on 09.09.2021 passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is just left with almost six months more service, therefore, he be retained at Begowal. He further submits that this Court, vide order dated 04.08.2021, had directed the learned State counsel to seek instructions in this regard as to if the petitioner can be accommodated at the place of posting at Begowal.

List on 23.09.2021.

In the meantime, respondents are directed to sympathetically consider the case of the petitioner for posting/retention at Begowal or at nearby place and inform the Court on the next date of hearing.”

Today on the resumed hearing of the case, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition has become infructuous as

substantial relief, as prayed for in the writ petition, has been granted. He submits that on 22.09.2021, the respondents have passed an appropriate order.

In view of the above, no further order is called for and the writ petition stands disposed of as infructuous.
