This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail has been moved by petitioner in case FIR No.115 dated 19.07.2021 under Sections 120-B, 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-17 Central, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for U.T. Chandigarh, assisted by learned counsel for complainant submit that compliance of order dated 03.08.2021 has not been made by the petitioner till date as in terms of undertaking given by petitioner, he was required to deposit an amount of Rs.14,10,750/- in the Court concerned and that too within 10 days positively. He further submits that time to deposit the abovesaid amount was extended for another one month, vide order dated 14.10.2021 and despite that petitioner has failed to do the needful till date. He further submits that on account of default made at the instance of petitioner, interim relief granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 03.08.2021, may be vacated.

In view of above, since petitioner has utterly failed to comply with order dated 03.08.2021 and subsequent order dated 14.10.2021, interim relief granted to the petitioner vide order dated 03.08.2021 stands vacated and petition is dismissed for non-compliance of the said order.
