1. This order shall dispose off the aforesaid two petitions i.e. CRM-M-26519-2020 filed on behalf of Manoj Yadav and CRM-M-7384-2020 filed on behalf of Dayawati, seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against them vide FIR No.455 dated 09.09.2019 at Police Station Sector 9-A, District Gurugram, under Sections 419/420/467/468/471/120-B/448 IPC.

2. The allegations, in nutshell, are to the effect that the accused got a sale deed executed in respect of a land belonging to the complainant's husband on the basis of power of attorney four months after the death of complainant's husband.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner/s have submitted that the FIR in question came to be lodged under some misunderstanding and that the matter has been amicably resolved amongst the parties.
4. The aforesaid position is not disputed by Mr. J.S.Thakur, Advocate, representing the complainant, who has expressed that he has no objection for acceptance of the instant petitions for anticipatory bail.
5. In view of the aforestated position, wherein the matter is stated to have been amicably resolved amongst the parties, both the petitions are accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order/s dated 08.09.2020 in CRM-M-26519-2020 and 24.02.2020 in CRM-M-7384-2020 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
