Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been moved by petitioner for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.291 dated 05.12.2019 under Sections 120-B, 420 and 511 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 31, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for U.T. Chandigarh, on instructions from Inspector Rohit, submits that in compliance of order dated 04.09.2020 and subsequent order dated 27.10.2020, petitioner has already joined investigation and he is not required for further investigation or any kind of custodial interrogation.

In view of above, order dated 04.09.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute subject to the condition that he shall surrender his passport to the Investigating Officer within seven days positively. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
