JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition that has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in FIR No.397 dated 02.09.2020 registered under Sections 363, 366-A IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act at Police Station Jind, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that the petitioner has been implicated falsely in the said FIR and is in custody since 06.09.2020. It is argued that the victim and her mother have been examined. They have not supported the prosecution version and have turned hostile. It is further argued that the trial is likely to take some time to conclude. Since material witnesses have already been examined, possibility of influencing them would not arise and therefore, prays for grant of concession of bail to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State opposes grant of bail to the petitioner by contending that the allegations levelled against him are

serious in nature, however, she does not dispute the fact that the material witnesses have been examined, who did not support the prosecution versions.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties. Keeping in view the fact that the material witnesses have been examined, who did not support the prosecution version and the fact that the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, no useful purpose would be served in keeping the petitioner behind bars. The instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal/surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate. However, any observation made herein shall not be construed to be an expression on merits of the case.
