The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondent No.2 to release the arrears of salary w.e.f. 15.06.2018 to 25.09.2018 and the annual increment w.e.f. 01.03.2019 and further to release four year prop-step-up dues from 01.03.2015 and leave encashment and to pay the difference of pay fixation arrears of revised higher pay scale effective w.e.f. 04.11.1996 and fixation of

salary along with all the dues, re-pay fixation benefits, compensation, damages etc. along with interest @ 18% per annum along with pndente lite and further seeking a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to fix the pension of the petitioner and release the arrears of the pension along with interest in the interest of justice.
