1 By this petition, though the petitioner has sought a
declaration that Section 69 and 132 of Central Goods and Services
Tax Act, 2017 are violative of Articles 14, 20 & 21 of the
Constitution of India, yet the only effective relief which has been
sought is that the respondents may not take coercive steps against the
petitioner.

2 It is not disputed that a Division Bench vide order dated 12.03.2021 in ***CWP No.1393 of 2021 titled as Narinder Chugh Vs. Union of India & others*** has held that for this relief the remedy is to file a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. before the Competent Court.

3 In the circumstances, we dispose of this petition with
liberty to the petitioner to move an application under Section 438
Cr.P.C. for anticipatory bail.

4 Petition stands disposed of with the above terms.

5 Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil
Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
