JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.325 dated 05.06.2020 under Sections 406, 420, 370 of IPC (Section 384 of IPC added later on) and Section 24 of Immigration Act registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that the challan has been presented and nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned A.A.G., Haryana, on instructions from ASI Singh Raj submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 26.10.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
