This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.110 dated 26.07.2020 under Sections 458, 447, 427, 323, 506, 511, 379-B, 148 and 149 of IPC and Sections 25, 27, (Act No.54) of Arms Act registered at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, have joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned D.A.G., Punjab, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 04.09.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
