Prayer in this 2nd petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in FIR No.51 dated 26.05.2020, for offence punishable under Section 22 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

The earlier one was dismissed on 02.12.2020. The operative part of the said order, reads as under:-

“After hearing the counsel for the parties, considering the fact that the petitioner – Inderjeet Singh is involved in as many as 04 other FIRs under the NDPS Act, I find no ground to grant the concession of bail to the petitioner – Inderjeet Singh and accordingly, the petition i.e. CRM-M No.21631 of 2020, is dismissed.”
