SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of a direction to official respondents No. 1 to 3 to conduct fair and proper investigation and to register an FIR against private respondents.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 was attacked by Dhian Singh, Lovepreet Singh, Jashan and Sarbjit Kaur, who were armed, and they caused injuries upon him. By referring to the MLR dated 12.07.2021 (Annexure P-1), he urges that the injuries No.1 and 2 inflicted upon the petitioner, have been declared as simple, whereas injury No.3 has been declared as grievous. Counsel submits that before approaching this Court, the petitioners have submitted complaints dated

17.07.2021 and 23.07.2021 to the Senior Superintendent of Police Gurdaspur – respondent No.2, however, the same has not been attended to. He submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned respondent to look into the complaint.

Request made by counsel for the petitioners has been considered.

Without examining and expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the complaints, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police Gurdaspur – respondent No.2 to examine the complaint dated 23.07.2021 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner No.1 and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the complaint dated 23.07.2021 (Annexure P-3) along with the petition be communicated to respondent No.2 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
