The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.94 dated 09.04.2021, under Sections 323, 324, 34, 427, 452, 506 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Dujana, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner was attributed an injury with an iron rod on the face of the complainant which resulted in a broken tooth. He further contends that offence under Section 307 IPC was added after 20 days of the incident. The petitioner is in custody for about 1½ months since his arrest on 26.06.2021. The wife of the petitioner is at an advanced stage of pregnancy. He has referred to the copy of the medical certificate at Annexure P-4. He also contends that as the petitioner and the complainant are the residents of the same village, the petitioner will try to settle the matter amicably.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Vijender Kumar, states that the petitioner is involved in five other cases and the matter had

earlier been compromised with the complainant and later, the petitioner had attacked the complainant and his wife.

Heard.

In view of the above especially when the petitioner is in custody for about 1½ months, the Covid-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, the petitioner shall appear before the Police Station Dujana, District Jhajjar on every alternate Monday, he shall also furnish his mobile number to the concerned SHO and shall keep the location of his phone on till the conclusion of the trial. The petitioner will not try to influence the witnesses in any manner whatsoever.
