Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to remove the anomaly between the pay of senior and junior government employees.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 09.02.2021 (P-10) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, AAG Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondents No. 2 to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice (P-10) in

accordance with law by passing speaking order preferably within a period of four months from today.
