Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No.184 dated 28.6.2019, under Sections 302, 147, 148, 149 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 39, District Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that while disposing of the bail petition filed by co-accused, this Court vide order dated 21.1.2021 ordered that the prosecution witnesses be examined within four months. He submits that there is non-compliance of order.

Mr. A.M. Punchhi, PP for UT Chandigarh submits that further four months were granted vide order dated 25.7.2021. There were forty-one prosecution witnesses, last witness is being examined today. He further submits that entire prosecution evidence will be concluded within one week from today.

In view of the statement made, petition is disposed of.

There is no doubt that in case a request is made by the parties before the Court concerned to grant early date so that the evidence of prosecution can be recorded within ten days from today, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
