1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.61 dated 16.07.2020 registered under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC at Women Police Station, Chandigarh.

2. By an order dated 03.09.2020, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioners and directed them to join investigation.
