The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.05 dated 6.5.2021 registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station, NRI Amritsar, District Amritsar.

By virtue of the order dated 5.8.2021, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 5.8.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
