Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This is the second petition for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.21, dated 14.04.2019, registered under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 379/411 IPC, at Police Station Arif Ke, District Ferozepur.

The first petition filed by the petitioner for grant of bail was dismissed on 17.10.2019, with the following order:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.21, dated 14.04.2019, registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act and Sections 379/411 IPC, at Police Station Arif Ke, District Ferozepur.

The alleged recovery from the petitioner is 270 gram heroine which falls in commercial quantity. Petitioner is involved in another case under the NDPS Act when he was in prison. Apart therefrom, petitioner is also involved in one case of attempt to murder and 3 more criminal cases.

Hence, no ground to grant concession of regular bail is made out, particularly when the custody of the petitioner is 5 months and 26 days only.

Dismissed.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner, although, made a sincere attempt, however, failed to draw the attention of the court to any new circumstances or fresh ground for granting bail.

Hence, dismissed.

However, learned trial court is requested to make a sincere endeavour for the expeditious disposal of the trial.
