Heard through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.38 dated 10.02.2021, under Sections 307, 506, 34, 120-B IPC and 25, 27, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Beri, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of no injury as no one was injured in the occurrence. It is alleged that shots were fired but they did not hit anyone. The petitioner is in custody for over 6 months since his arrest on 11.02.2021. The son of the petitioner is also in custody.

Learned State counsel contends that charges have been framed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 6 months, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
