Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation from an independent agency or from a superior officer in FIR No.82, dated 10.07.2021, registered under Sections 306 IPC at Police Station Division No.4, Ludhiana, as the accused who are influential persons are creating hindrance in the investigation and pressurizing the respondent No.4 to cancel the FIR registered against them.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that for the redressal of her grievance, the petitioner has already filed a representation dated 03.07.2021 (Annexure P-2) before the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, but no action has been taken so far.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Manreet Singh Nagra, A.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and find the prayer to be just and reasonable.

In view of the above position, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana i.e. Respondent No.3 to consider the representation 03.07.2021 (Annexure P-2) and decide the same expeditiously in accordance with law.
