Writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution has been filed, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider and grant the petitioner benefit of ACP Scheme on completion of 4/9/14 years of service in one cadre of her service with all consequential benefits including re-fixation of pay, payment of arrears along with interest for the delay.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, submits that at this stage, instead of pressing the petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case, legal notice dated 13.10.2019 (P-10) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Addl.A.G., Punjab, who is present through video-conference, accepts notice on behalf

of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.1, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 13.10.2019 (P-10), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of four months from today.
