This is a first application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0134 dated 21.05.2021 under Sections 307/506 IPC, registered at Police Station Chheharta, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the complainant in the present case is the wife of the petitioner. After the registration of FIR, a compromise has been effected on 29.06.2021 and as per the said compromise, the complainant has no objection in case the present FIR is quashed. An affidavit of the said complainant has been annexed as Annexure P-2. It has further been submitted that on the basis of the said compromise, **CRM-M-27707-2021** has been filed for quashing the

FIR on the basis of compromise, in which the counsel for the wife as well as the son has appeared and has admitted the factum of compromise. It has been stated that the petitioner as well as the wife and the son are happily living together and that the petitioner has been in custody for the last 02 months and 21 days and is not involved in any other case.

Learned counsel for the State of Punjab has produced the custody certificate dated 13.08.2021 which is taken on record. The said custody certificate fortifies the fact that the petitioner has undergone 02 months and 21 days of actual custody and that he is not involved in any other case.

Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances, moreso the fact that the matter has now been compromised and the parties are seeking quashing of the FIR, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Duty Magistrate/CJM concerned.
