Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 & 2 to step up the pay of the petitioners at par with their junior (proforma respondent No.3) w.e.f. 01.04.2015. Further prayer is for directing the respondents to decide the application/representation(s) dated 21.02.2021/26.02.2021 (P-10).

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case the representation(s) dated 21.02.2021/26.02.2021 (P-10) are considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of

respondent Nos.1 & 2 and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Director Public Instructions (SE), Punjab to consider and decide the aforesaid representation(s) dated 21.02.2021/26.02.2021 (P-10) in accordance with law by passing speaking order preferably within a period of 04 (four) months from today.
