JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

This is a second petition that has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.265 dated 26.09.2017 registered under Sections 307, 341, 506, 427, 323, 148, 149 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Division No.7, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the said matter. It is argued that an FIR came to be registered on the allegation that the petitioner herein snatched a pistol from the hands of one Sikh person who was accompanying him with an intention to kill the complainant. He also fired a shot on the complainant which pierced through the body passing other side of his heart and the second shot was fired at the wife of the complainant. It is further

argued that the petitioner is in custody since 28.05.2021. It is submitted that a compromise has been effected between the petitioner and complainant-respondent No.2, thus, prays for grant of regular bail to the petitioner herein.

At this stage, appearance has been caused on behalf of the counsel for complainant-respondent No.2 and submits that he has no objection in case bail is allowed to the petitioner herein.

I have heard counsel for the parties. Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in mind that a compromise has been effected between the petitioner and complainant-respondent No.2 and further that complainant-respondent No.2 has no objection in case bail is allowed to the petitioner herein, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his execution of adequate personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned trial court/Duty Magistrate.
