This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to hold an enquiry into the alleged misplacement of the original Gun Licence of the petitioner, deposited on 30.03.2000 for its renewal and endorsement of Arms and not returning the same to the petitioner. It is further prayed that the respondents be directed to consider the case of the petitioner and take the final decision on the representation of the petitioner dated 15.06.2021 (Annexure P-7) by passing a well reasoned speaking order within a time bound frame.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents take a conscious decision on the representation of the petitioner dated 15.06.2021 (Annexure P-7) and pass a speaking order thereon, within a time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Shireesh Gupta, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 15.06.2021 (Annexure P-7) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
