This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of appropriate direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to take strict remedial action as per statutory provision of the criminal law against respondents No.5 and 6 on the basis of complaint dated 05.05.2021 and representation dated 29.07.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that the petitioner herein had created a marriage profile on an online matrimonial site i.e. shaadi.com. and within a few days, the petitioner received a message from respondent No.5-Bhagwant Singh alias Rohit regarding marriage proposal. The said respondent asked for a mobile number and started talking to the petitioner. On 11.11.2020, respondent No.5 met the petitioner in Chandigarh and thereafter he promised to marry with her. He took her to a hotel in Zirakpur where he had already booked a room and tried to make

physical relationship against the wishes of the petitioner on the pretext of marriage. Again they met on 11.12.2020 and again he promised the marry and forced the petitioner to have a sexual relationship with him against her wishes on the pretext of marriage. The petitioner thereafter became pregnant and the said respondent advised for a forcible abortion otherwise he would kill her. Counsel further contends that despite the complaint and a subsequent representation, no action has been taken thereon.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Vasundhara Dalal Anand, APP, UT, Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and would submit that the matter has been investigated and an FIR No.92, dated- 07.08.2021, under Sections 376 IPC, Police Station Mauli Jagran, Chandigarh already stands registered against respondent No.5 i.e. Bhagwant Singh alias Rohit Singh son of Rajender Singh Bisht. It is argued that an attempt has been made to arrest him and arrest warrants have also been issued in this regard.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the fact that the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed, no further orders are called for and the present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
