An affidavit has been filed by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Circle Samana, Patiala on behalf of State of Punjab in the connected petition i.e CRM-M-31655-2021 which has been allowed on an even date and learned State counsel has stated that aforesaid affidavit be adopted in the present case as well.

Mr. Karanbir Singh, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab while referring to the affidavit filed by the State has submitted that after the investigation was conducted it was found that the death was caused due to the accident and not due to the *mala fide* intention of the petitioner or the co-accused. The learned Assistant Advocate General has

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further submitted that a cancellation report has also been prepared which has been approved by the SSP, Patiala. He on instructions from ASI Bhagwan Singh has further submitted that in pursuance of the orders passed by this Court on 09.08.2021 the petitioner has already joined investigation and he is fully cooperating with the investigation process and in view of the aforesaid factual position he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 09.08.2021 is hereby made absolute.
