GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

Petitioner – Bhagirathi, stated to be aged 64 years, has filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with a prayer to direct respondents to decide the representation dated 27.07.2020 (Annexure P-3) and direct the respondents to release entire benefits, gratuity, leave encashment and fix the pension and release the same.

Records of the case show that this Court on 04.09.2020 had issued notice of motion.

Today on resumed hearing of the case, learned counsel for respondents submits that all the retiral benefits of the petitioner have been released.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that the petitioner had also made a specific request and prayer in the present petition that the retiral benefits which are released after some delay, be released

along with interest.

Without commenting on merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner moves a representation within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, for the left over dues i.e. interest on delayed payment etc., the said representation be decided by the respondents/Competent Authority, in accordance with law, within a period of *two months* therefrom.

Ordered accordingly.
