Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to make the payment of maintenance bills amounting to Rs.4,03,772.42/- in lieu of the maintenance work of new connectivity of Poohla to Kothe Mehne Ke under PMGSY, Phase-X, Package No.PB-0215 (World Bank RRP-II), executed by the petitioner, along with interest @ 12% per annum.

At the outset, learned State Counsel, on instructions from Sh. R.K.Sharma, SDO, has apprised the Court that amount due on account of the payment of bill(s) has already been paid to the petitioner on 09.03.2021. In support of his contention, learned State Counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit dated 25.03.2021 of Er. Inderjit Singh, Executive Engineer, Provincial

Division, PWD B&R, Bathinda on behalf of the respondents. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned Counsel for the petitioner.

Since grievance of the petitioner stands redressed, therefore, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter. Consequently, present petition is disposed off.

Needless to say that if petitioner still feels aggrieved, he would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.
