Prayer in the present application is for preponement of date of hearing of the main case from 28.01.2022 to some early date.

Heard.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. The date of hearing is preponed from 28.01.2022 to today.

CRM-27303-2021 & CRM-M-25202-2019

CRM-27303-2021 has been filed by the respondent-applicant for disposal of the main petition as the same has been rendered infructuous.

It is averred in the application that the main petition preferred by the petitioners is for setting aside of the order dated 16.05.2019 passed by the learned Sessions Judge, SAS Mohali, whereby his application for transfer of civil suit and complaints under Section 138, 141 and 142 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 pending in the Court of Sh. Amit Bakshi,

Civil Judge (Junior Division), SAS Nagar to any other court of competent jurisdiction, had been dismissed by the learned Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar.

It is further mentioned in the application that the main petition has been rendered infructuous as the learned Presiding Officer from whose court the complaints were sought to be transferred has since been transferred and now the present complaints are pending adjudication before the Court presided over by some other Officer.

In view of the above, CRM-27303-2021 is allowed and the main petition (CRM-M-25202-2019) is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
