This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Prayer in this writ petition is for a direction to the respondents to correct the surname/name of parents of petitioner no.1 in his birth certificate dated 03.10.2004.

It is submitted that it was realized that name of parents of petitioner no.1 is incorrectly mentioned in his birth certificate. Father's name of petitioner no.1, is mentioned as 'Rama Shankar Yadav' instead of 'Rama Shankar' and mother's name is 'Rekha' instead of 'Rekha Devi'. Learned counsel submits that petitioner no.1 is facing difficulty at the time of his admission in educational institutions. It is further submitted that petitioners approached official respondents for necessary correction, however no action is being taken.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State, to whom an advance copy of the writ petition has been supplied, on instructions from Dr. Arun

Deep, Medical Officer, Additional District Registrar (Birth and Death), Panchkula, submits that proper application with complete details, was never submitted by petitioner no.1 and neither was the application submitted at the correct portal i.e. Antyodaya Saral Portal. In case, proper application is submitted alongwith necessary documents, action shall be taken thereon immediately and definitely within four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that necessary application along with documents, shall be submitted at the Antyodaya Saral Portal within one week from today. In case, such an application is submitted by the petitioners, the same be considered by the competent authority within four weeks thereafter. Needless to say, in case, any documents are required of the petitioners, intimation thereof shall be given to the petitioners by the official respondents.

Writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
