Prayer in this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case, FIR No. 356 dated 23.06.2021 registered under Sections 313, 323, 354-A, 406, 498-A and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 at Police Station HTM Hisar, District Hisar.

Reply by way of affidavit of Rajbir Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hisar-1 has been filed on behalf of respondent-State in the Registry which is taken on record.

I have heard learned Counsel for the parties and gone through the case file.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has, while reiterating submissions made on 06.08.2021, submitted that in compliance with

order dated 06.08.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and she may be granted anticipatory bail.

Learned State Counsel has acknowledged that in compliance with the order dated 06.08.2021 passed by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation on 21.09.2021 and has further submitted that the petitioner has been found innocent as the allegations leveled against her have not been proved and that her custodial interrogation in the present case is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 06.08.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of accordingly.
