The private respondents i.e. respondents No.4 and 5 moved the Divisional Canal Officer for shifting head of outlet from RD-8800-R to RD-6900-R and further to transfer 113/113 acres of land belonging to them from RD-19440-L to RD-6900-R. The application filed has been allowed and appeal before the Superintending Canal Officer has failed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that transfer of head of outlet RD-8800-R to RD-6900-R shall adversely affect the land of the petitioners as the same will not receive any irrigation. This is because of the fact that the level of the land is higher.

The argument though attractive cannot be accepted as counsel for the petitioners has been unable to substantiate the same from the record.

Thus, the writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
