CWP-13574-2020; CWP-13578-2020; CWP-13881-2020; CWP-13881-2020; CWP-13613-2020 and CWP-13657-2020 along with cheques bearing No.091811 amounting to Rs.8,80,000/-; No.091814 amounting to Rs.3,25,000/-; No.091812 amounting to Rs.5,80,000/-; No.091813 amounting to Rs.8,50,000/- dated 05.08.2021 drawn at Central Bank of India, have also been submitted through e-mail.
