SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)

In this petition, the petitioner, who is the accused in F.I.R No.337 dated 29.08.2014, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of IPC read with Section 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra (Annexure P-1), has prayed for quashing of F.I.R. with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

2. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the parties have arrived at a settlement vide Compromise (Annexure P-3), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. The Ld. Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Kurukshetra, vide report dated 21.09.2020

has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties

is genuine and without any pressure.

3. Respondent Nos.2 & 3 who are legal heirs of complainant are represented by their Counsel who does not dispute the factum of compromise.

4. In view of the report of the Ld. Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Kurukshetra, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *“Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543* and *“Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another”, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the Respondent Nos.2 & 3 have themselves compromised the dispute with the accused.

5. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. F.I.R No.337 dated 29.08.2014, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of IPC read with Section 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed *qua* the present petitioner.
