The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID-19.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 209 dated 03.11.2019 under Sections 148, 149, 380 and 457 IPC registered at Police Station City Patti, District Tarn Taran and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR, as the matter stands amicably settled in terms of compromise dated 20.08.2020.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 appeared.

Vide order dated 18.11.2020, the parties were directed to appear before the Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate on 10.12.2020 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise.

A report dated 17.12.2020 of learned JMIC, Patti, has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned JMIC, Patti and got recorded their statements regarding compromise. Learned Magistrate has stated that he is of the considered view that the compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 209 dated 03.11.2019 under Sections 148, 149, 380 and 457 IPC registered at Police Station City Patti, District Tarn Taran along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
