Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.194 dated 27.06.2020 registered under Sections 353, 186, 332, 34 IPC at Police Station Patran, District Patiala.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that as per the allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of Narinder Kumar, 02 unidentified persons have caused him beatings while performing his official duty. It is also submitted that a compromise has been effected between the parties.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that there is no other case pending against the petitioner and the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Counsel for the complainant has also acknowledged the factum of compromise between the parties and submits that he has no

objection, if the petition is allowed.

After hearing the counsel for the parties, considering the fact that the dispute of which the present petition is an off-shoot, has been settled between the parties, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer within a period of 10 days to join investigation and he shall be released on interim bail on furnishing bail/surety bonds subject to the following conditions:-

1. *He shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
2. *He shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and*
3. *He shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.*
