Case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 118 dated 27.06.2021, registered at Police Station City Jagaron, District Ludhiana under Sections 18 and 29 (added subsequently) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Status report by way of affidavit of DSP, Jagraon, District Ludhiana (Rural) dated 07.10.2021 has been filed on behalf of respondent-State through e-mail. Copy of the same is taken on record.

Vide order dated 06.08.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the

investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Darshan Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 06.08.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
