The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 4(1)(a) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) 1988 for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant furlough to the petitioner for a period of two weeks.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate direction is issued to respondent No.3 to look into the application (Annexures P-2) submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate action under the provisions of law.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed by the learned counsel for the petitioner, respondents No. 3-Superintendent of Jail, Neemka Jail, Faridabad, District Faridabad is directed to look into the application of

the petitioner representation/complaint (Annexures P-2) and decide the same within two weeks, if any, required under the provisions of law.
