Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 180 dated 05.07.2021, under Sections 379-B, 411 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged in the FIR, which has been registered on the basis of secret information, that the petitioner and other accused had been stealing mobile phones. However, there is no reference to any specific incident of theft of mobile phones. He also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

This Court, by the order dated 09.08.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Jasvir Kaur, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 09.08.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
