HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 5 to 10.

The petitioners are neighbours of private respondents No. 5 to 10. It is the case of the petitioners that private respondents No. 5 to 10 have been repeatedly harassing and threatening the petitioners. The private respondents have entered into the house of the petitioners more than once armed with swords and other weapons. They have abused and physically assaulted the petitioners. They have not even spared petitioner No.3, who is aged about 84 years. Time and again complaints have been submitted before respondent No.4 the local Station House officer (SHO) and respondent No.3-The Deputy

Superintendent of Police. At one stage with the intervention of the police a compromise was also effected between the parties. Even thereafter the private respondents have not resisted and continuously harassing and threatening the petitioners.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to look into the representation dated 26.07.2021 (P-4) and take such action as may be warranted in law.
