MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, in case FIR No. 28, dated 29.06.2021, lodged under Sections 498-A, 420, 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Women, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel contends that the petitioners, who are the parents-in-law of the complainant's daughter, have been falsely implicated in the FIR in question on account of a matrimonial dispute between the complainant's daughter and her husband (son of the petitioners). It has been further submitted that daughter of the complainant resided in India only for a short while and left for Canada with her husband. Learned counsel further contends that that it was in Canada that a dispute between her and her husband arose, hence, there was no occasion for the petitioners to subject the complainant's daughter to the harassment as alleged in the FIR in

question.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to order dated 09th August, 2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Tasveer Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioners having joined investigation and has apprised the Court that their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 09th August, 2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
