The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.469 dated 24.11.2016, under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sector 5, District Panchkula

A Coordinate Bench of this Court, by order dated 29.05.2019 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Pardeep Kumar, states that in terms of the order of the Coordinate Bench dated 29.05.2019, the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 29.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
