The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the selection process for making promotion to the post of Assistant Manager; made by the respondent-Bank; wherein marks of the candidates has not been disclosed by the respondent-Bank, along with certain other prayers.

A perusal of the paper book shows that the petitioner has raised his grievance against the process of selection for making promotions to the post of Assistant Manager with the respondent-Bank. Undisputedly, the process of selection is already over. Therefore, this

court does not find any reason to interfere at this stage qua the process of selection as such.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
