Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 09 dated 08.01.2019, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Dhand, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner had taken a loan on the basis of forged documents. He, however, contends that the petitioner has returned the entire loan amount. He has referred to the copy of the NOC at Annexure P3. He further contends that co-accused, namely, Jaj Singh and Suresh Kumar have been granted anticipatory bail by this Court in CRM-M No. 19506 of 2021 and CRM-M No. 24476 of 2021, respectively.

This Court, by the order dated 09.08.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Shamsheer Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 09.08.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
