The instant petition is filed under Section 482 CrPC for quashing of General Diary No.43 dated 13.05.2021, P.S. Sohna, Gurugram registered as cross case in FIR No.99 dated 05.05.2021 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 354-B 395, 452 and 506 of the IPC registered at P.S. Sohna, District Gurugram and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 08.07.2021 (Annexure P-3).

Vide order dated 13.08.2021 of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on

31.08.2021 to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise arrived at, between them.

Report has since been received from the learned JMIC, Sohna, in pursuance to the direction of this Court. As per the report, compromise has indeed been effected between the parties and the same is without any pressure or coercion and out of their free will. The trial Court has annexed the statements of the parties in original along with its report.

Learned State counsel too submits that there are no other accused other than the petitioner Nos.1 to 26 and respondent Nos.2 to 7 are the aggrieved persons in the FIR in question.

In view of the report of the learned JMIC, Sohna, and the principles laid down by the Apex Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, and also by the Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the instant petition is allowed. The aforesaid General Diary No.43 dated 13.05.2021 and all consequential proceedings arising out of it, are quashed.

Needless to say the parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements recorded before the Court below.
